He noted that the Ames Area MPO will be required to reflect the performance measures and targets in all future planning document updates.

V. RECOMMENDATION ON ICAAP PROJECT APPLICATION

Mr. Thompson said the Ames Area MPO needs to review all ICCAP applications to make sure they are feasible and adhere to the AAMPO Transportation Planning Process. The City of Ames submitted for a resolution by the Ames Area MPO for the FFY 2024 ICAAAP grant cycle. The project is for Ames Traffic Network-Phase 4 (Fiber Network & Adaptive Control). Funds will be available in FY 2024, which starts on October 1, 2023.
