III. RECCOMENDATION ON DRAFT FFY 2025-29 PASSENGER TRANSPORTATION PLAN (PTP)

Shari Atwood, CyRide Transit Planner, the Iowa Department of Transportation requires that MPO's develop and promote coordinated passenger transportation planning programs. The MPO conducts the coordination through the Story County Transportation Collaboration Committee that meets quarterly throughout the year. The FTA requires that enhanced mobility of seniors and individuals with disabilities funding be coordinated through the PTP process. The funding is designed to meet the transportation needs of older adults and people with disabilities when other services are not available or insufficient.

Ms. Atwood discussed the overall PTP goals and how often the plan needs to be submitted. Ms. Atwood noted what should be included in the plan to be submitted by May 2024. The plan is divided into five different sections. Ms. Atwood provided an overview and requirements for each section of the Passenger Transportation Plan.
